


Research Awards



Partnership Grants

Centre of Research Excellence in Pulmonary Fibrosis (CRE-PF)

The Lung Foundation Australia Hope Research Fund was pleased to provide \$960,000 in funding from a \$5.3m five-year grant to the University of Sydney and the Centre of Research Excellence in Interstitial Lung Disease (CREILD). This funding supports important research and services commenced under the former CRE-PF.

Heart of Australia

\$50,000 for Occupational Lung Disease research.

Primary Ciliary Dyskinesia Australia

Collaboration with PCD Australia to fund research in Primary Ciliary Dyskinesia, valued at \$30,000.

Cancer Australia

\$900,000 invested in early-career research grants, to 2029, through the Priority-driven Collaborative Cancer Research Scheme (PdCCRS) with two grants funded in 2024 to the value of \$150,000.

TSANZ and LAM Australia Research Alliance

Collaboration with TSANZ and the LAM Australia Research Alliance to fund research in lymphangioleiomyomatosis, valued at \$108,000.
